Materials:

- 1) Classical Era booklet
- 2) Classical Era Music History Worksheet
- 3) Eras of Music History Review Worksheet (keep from February)
- 4) Eras of Music History Lapbook (keep from February)
- 5) W.A. Mozart Lapbook, OR
- 6) L. van Beethoven Lapbook

* Every student will receive a Mozart booklet and a Beethoven booklet, as well as representative pieces of music for each composer. However, each student will assemble only one lapbook of their choice: EITHER Mozart OR Beethoven.

Suggested At-Home Projects:

The easiest (and least stressful) way to complete these suggested at-home projects is to pace yourself week to week. I have listed suggested weekly projects, and will distribute lapbook components a week at a time.

- 1) Read Classical Era booklet
- 2) Complete Classical Era Music History Worksheet
- 3) Eras of Music History Review Worksheet: complete Classical Era column (older students only)
- 4) Eras of Music History Lapbook: glue in envelope pocket under “Baroque Era” pocket, and label with “Classical Era” cutout. Color and cut out Classical Era pictures and put these into the envelope.
- 5) W.A. Mozart Lapbook
 - 1) Week 1: Complete and assemble lapbook cover and large pocket elements, except “Mozart’s Jobs” (but leave room on the large pocket for this!).
 - 2) Week 2: Complete and assemble “Mozart’s Jobs”.
 - 3) Week 3: Listen to Mozart’s variations on “Ah vous dirai-ja, maman” and follow the motif pattern on the worksheet. “Mozart’s Family” and “Mozart’s Sister’s Name”.
 - 4) Week 4: Complete and glue onto large pocket Mozart’s booklet. Cut out and glue in “What does Mozart’s Music Sound Like?” and “Mozart’s Full Name”.
 - 5) All month long: read Mozart booklet in lapbook, read Mozart stories in books in Studio.
- 6) L. van Beethoven Lapbook
 - 1) Week 1: Complete and assemble lapbook cover and large pocket elements
 - 2) Week 2: Complete and glue in “Beethoven’s 3 Compositional Periods” and Beethoven’s Famous Compositions”.
 - 3) Week 3: Listen to Beethoven’s Fifth Symphony, and complete the motif worksheet. Put this worksheet in the large pocket. Cut out, fold, and glue in “Dynamics” and “Sonata Form” Put the Heiligenstadt Testimony in the large pocket.
 - 4) Week 4: Cut out and glue in pocket for “Pictures of Beethoven”, and place pictures inside. Complete and glue in map and “Beethoven Composed...” items.
 - 5) All month long, read Beethoven booklet in lapbook, read Beethoven stories in books in Studio.
